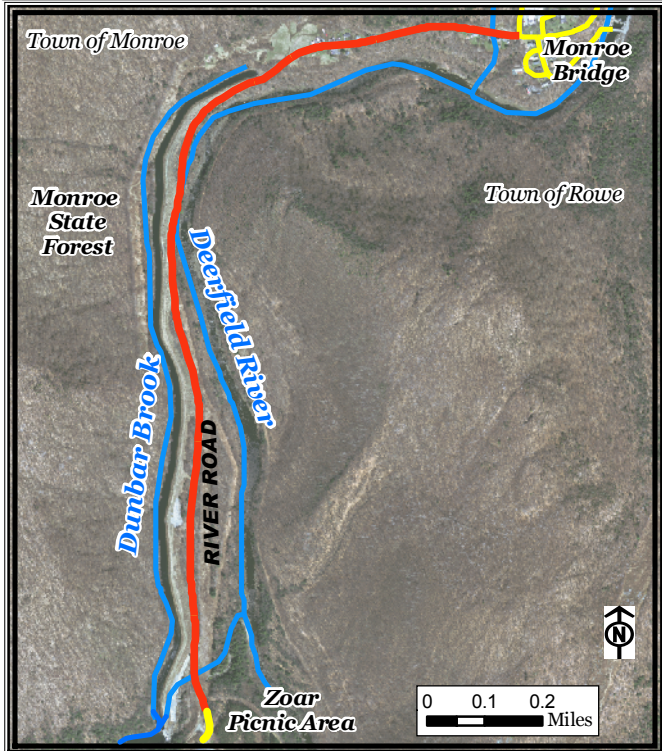


# Deerfield River Walking Route, Monroe

## Deerfield River Walking Route, Monroe

The **Deerfield River Walking Route** is a relatively flat 3.5-mile roundtrip walk in Monroe between the Deerfield River and Dunbar Creek on River Road. Often in the summer, you can see kayakers paddling down the Deerfield River. The route begins in Monroe Bridge and heads south on River Road to the Zoar Picnic Area, where one can stop to take in the views and have a picnic. If you are interested in additional walking, the Dunbar Brook Trail connects here from the Monroe State Park. The walking route then returns back to Monroe Bridge.

Just to the west of the route is the Monroe State Forest, which has additional walking trails. For more information on these trails and free maps, go to:
